### **Family Dining Parents Event.**

This week parents from Years 2-6 who have pre-ordered a lunch can come and join in family dining. Please can we ask parents to arrive for 11.50am so that we can seat you in the hall. Your lunch will be completed by 12.30 but you are welcome to stand and watch the second sitting when our older children take turns to serve.

At Shipley we have adopted a progressive approach to family dining to suit the needs of our children. It has taken a number of weeks to find what works best but we feel that our purpose and aims for family dining are now becoming embedded. Nursery, Reception and Year 1 are served by the kitchen staff and have their lunch on trays at the beginning of the year so that we can teach them manners, how to use a knife and folk correctly, teach them about the different foods that are on offer, sit appropriately at the table and encourage them to try new food. We aim for Year 1 to be joining a family dining experience by the end of year 1 in preparation for Year 2.

Year 2 and 3 are served by our Year 6 children and learn table manners, conversational skills and are encouraged to develop more independence, work as a team, build relationships and show respect for each other. Our Year 6 children learn responsibility, independence, communication skills, team skills and a sense of pride.

Year 4,5 and 6 serve themselves at their tables. By Year 4 our children understand the importance of independence and team skills and they organise themselves at their tables to serve their lunches, communicate effectively and ensure that everyone is treated equally and with respect.

We feel that family dining has had a hugely positive impact on our childrens independence, relationships between pupils and between age groups, their ability to try something new and their communication skills. We hope you enjoy your experience.
