You will now know your drop off and pick up times for September. To ease traffic on the pavement outside Mr Barker is marking a designated area on the playground that you will be able to go and stand (socially distanced) at the start of the day. This will only be for the class whose time it is to arrive. If you arrive earlier than your time you will have to stand outside the school grounds.

If you have more than one child to drop off at any one time there are some suggestions on the leaflet regarding what you could do to prepare. We have made a list of families this will affect and staff will be aware there could be a slight delay. As far as possible they will wait. However, we will be working to a strict time table. We recognise that the first day will be a little different and it may take slightly longer but hopefully as we get into the new normal it will become second nature.


